- There will be a Special Meeting held to discuss the possible merger on the ballot between Wallaceton and Boggs Township. Residents of both municipalities are encouraged to attend and have their voice heard. The meeting will be held here at the Boggs Township Municipal Building on Wednesday, November 2nd at 7 pm.
- Zito Media has advised Novembers bill will include an increase of \$2.75 for Local Channels and \$3.75/mo for the Cable Programming Charge.
- The Township received the yearly Fire Relief Funds in the amount of \$8,889 to be divided equally between BJW and Philipsburg Fire Companies.
- We received a notice from PennDot that our estimated Liquid Fuel allocation for 2023 is \$113,423.13
- On October 3rd the Commonwealth Court rejected the PA Waste LLC's appeal to build a dump in Boggs Township.
